The Officers and Members of the St. Leonard Volunteer Fire & Rescue Co. 7 Inc. (SLVFD) hope this letter finds you and your family healthy and safe. This spring and summer have been busy for the 100% volunteer membership at SLVFD. Since January 1st SLVFD has been dispatched on over 1900 calls for service and we are PROUD to report we continue to have a 100% response rate.

During the spring and summer of 2022 at SLVFD:

- we placed in service a 27' Boston Whaler Rescue Boat after hours of training by the membership.
- we had a successful return of our Junior Fire Camp, the camp gave incoming 5th 8th graders experience as a fire and rescue professional. The campers were provided with knowledge in fire safety, fire suppression, taught life lessons in teamwork and perseverance and every camper was certified in CPR.
- we continued to work with our apparatus vendors to prepare for the delivery of the new apparatus that will be coming this fall and early next year.
- we continued to support the community by participating in fire prevention and other community outreach programs such as supporting Camp Sheriff.

These accomplishments are just a snapshot of our busy spring and summer.

The St. Leonard Volunteer Fire Department and Rescue Squad is one of the last **TWO** 100% volunteer Fire, Rescue and EMS departments remaining in Calvert County and remain dedicated to serving the community. We are always recruiting new active and administrative members; membership applications are available online or at the station. All training is provided free of cost with many additional benefits for being a volunteer. The success of our department is made possible by both our active membership and the amazing generosity and support of our community and for that support we want to say a huge thank you.
